Notes for Team Kata Events:

Male and female competitors are in same event.

U11 teams must perform any one kata.

U15, Cadet and Senior teams must alternate between any two kata.

At least two competitors on a team must be in the correct age group. One younger person may be included on a team.

Notes for Individual Kata Events:

Competitors are ONLY allowed to compete in their own age group and belt category.

Competitors in the White - Orange belt sections need only perform any one kata.

Competitors in the Green - Purple (and the Masters White - Brown) belt sections must alternate between any two kata.

Competitors in the black belt sections must alternate between any three kata.

Kata Scoring:

Where needed, a points based eliminator round will be used to select the final 8 competitors in each kata event. The results from the eliminator round will be used to seed the quarter-finals.

Flags will be used in the quarter-finals, semi-finals and finals.

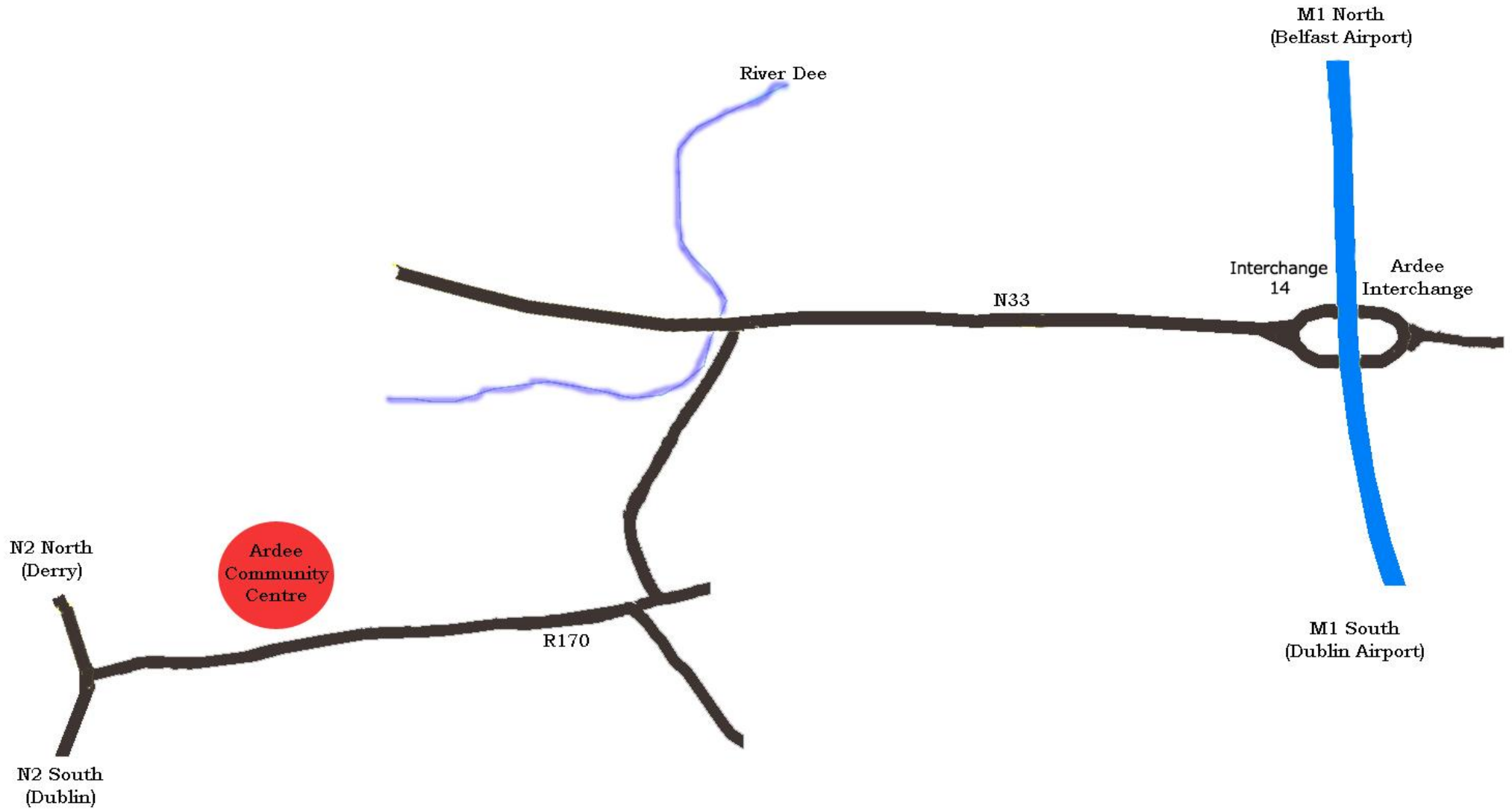
